For this update, we made the usual changes, bringing the Naval Vessel Register (NVR), MSC Ship Inventory, and the Maritime Administration's Property Management and Archive Record System (PMARS) data current as of 30 June 2010.

As a reminder, we refer you to our QuikLook pivot tables which will give you the composition of the Navy's Ship Battle Forces and Local Defense & Miscellaneous Support Forces at a glance. As of the end of June 2010, we count 288 ships in the Ship Battle Forces and 113 in the Local Defense & Miscellaneous Forces.
