Enclosure (1) is attached and forwarded for your information and use. It is the second quarter CY07 update to CNA's *Integrated Ship Database* (ISDB).

Other attached enclosures include: a “READ ME FIRST” file that describes basic features of the database and steps to take when first opening it [Encl (2)]; the distribution list for this version of the database [Encl (3)]; and the original database user’s manual from December 2005 [Encl (4)].


This version of the database incorporates the following changes:

- We updated the Naval Vessel Register (NVR) data through 30 June 2007.
- The data from the MSC Ship Inventory reflects changes as of 30 June 2007.
- The Maritime Administration’s Property Management and Archive Record System (PMARS) data is current as of 30 June 2007.

In addition, we added a new field to the database. This field, named “Abbrev,” contains ship name abbreviations. The abbreviations consist primarily of the 3-letter ship codes used for brevity in tactical displays and military messaging [a,b]. We also included 4-letter abbreviations by which some ships are also known, e.g. “CVIN” for USS CARL VINSON and “INDY” for the now-retired aircraft-carrier INDEPENDENCE.

We also modified the first worksheet in the data file, *DataTableOriginal*, so that Excel's *Autofilter* function can be used there. Users must still copy *DataTableOriginal* into the sheet, *DataTableCopy*, in order access all of Excel's functions. *DataTableOriginal* is a protected worksheet and cannot be changed without a password. However, a user can change anything as needed to a copy in *DataTableCopy*.
