Our upcoming event – From the Battlefield to the Home: Violence Against Women & Girls in Crises - will take place on Wednesday, June 28, 12:00-1:00 EDT via Zoom, and our keynote speakers will be Dr. Ilana Seff, research assistant professor at the Brown School of Public Health at Washington University in St. Louis and Cyril Bennouna, a doctoral candidate in the Department of Political Science at Brown University. The event will be moderated by Dr. Alina Potts, research scientist at the Global Women's Institute, and principal investigator of the Empowered Aid project.

The event will spotlight the lives of ordinary civilians during wartime, focusing in particular on how armed conflict shapes violence against women, youth, and children off the battlefield, from the community to household. The speakers will share the strategies that work best to prevent violence against women and girls in crises and good practice principles of intervention, including how to employ an intersectional approach to ensure no vulnerable individuals are left behind.
